Transport for Attleborough – Highway Improvement Works Surrogate Street

As you may be aware, Norfolk County Council and their contractors are due to commence improvement works in the town of Attleborough later this summer.

The first part of the works will include signalling the junction of Church Street / Norwich Road, widening and upgrading Surrogate Street from one-way to two-way, providing a right turn lane into Besthorpe Road, installation of a number of controlled pedestrian crossings, reconfiguring the Station Road / Connaught Road / Surrogate Street junction, and widening the footways and renewing paving on Church Street.

These works are due to commence late August and from 3 September 2018 a number of temporary traffic restrictions will apply within the town;

- Church Street (outbound onto Norwich Road) – Road closure from 3 September for one week, 7pm to 6am.
- Besthorpe Road (western end) – Road closure from 3 September until 17 September. An additional road closure will be required from 19 October to 8 November during Surrogate Street works.
- Church Street – Suspension of on street car parking, from 11 September for a period of one month.
- Surrogate Street – The eastern side footway to be closed from 19 October to 8 November, including entrance from Besthorpe Road and exit into Thieves Lane. The western side footway to be closed for works from 8 November to 23 November, including entrance from Church Street and exit into Connaught Road.

- Church Street / Besthorpe Road / Surrogate Street / Norwich Road / Connaught Road / Station Road – Overnight road closures for road resurfacing for five days from 15 November.

The dates given above are proposed, and while we will endeavour to adhere to our programme, the dates are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances and weather issues. In the event of a change of dates or information we will do our best to keep all parties informed. In the event of all closures, diversion routes will be in place and clearly signed, and access to properties will be maintained.

Other elements of the work will be carried out under lane closures and temporary traffic signals. Where footway closures are required, alternative pedestrian routes shall be provided.

We anticipate the overall programme of works will take approximately 16 weeks to complete. Norfolk County Council would like to thank you for your patience and apologise for any inconvenience caused during the works.
